

Brighter Leaders Privacy Policy

Thank you for visiting Brighter Leader's website.

You can choose to communicate in several ways, including through accounts in social media or via calls or emails.

This is how the following information that you provide yourself is handled:

Your name and contact information (phone number, email)

Information about your question, point of view or case.

The data is not stored for a longer period than is necessary for the purposes for which the personal data is processed.

Brighter Leaders will not sell, disclose or distribute personal information to third parties. Furthermore, your personal data may be disclosed if applicable law or court decision so prescribes it or if such disclosure is otherwise necessary to participate in a legal investigation.

Everyone has the right to the protection of the personal data relating to him or her. The right to the protection of personal data is not an absolute right; it must be understood on the basis of its role in society and weighed against other fundamental rights in accordance with the principle of proportionality.

More and more people are making their personal information publicly available, worldwide. Technology has transformed both the economy and social life, and should further facilitate the free flow of personal data within the Union as well as transfers to third countries and international organizations, while ensuring a high level of protection of personal data.

Regulation of the European Parliament and of the Council 2016/679 or GDPR (General Data Protection Regulation) which entered into force 25/5/2018, states that:

"The processing of personal data is only lawful if and to the extent that at least one of the following conditions is met:

The data subject has given his consent to his personal data being processed for one or more specific purposes. (art 6 p.1.a)

If the processing is based on consent, the person responsible for personal data must be able to show that the data subject has consented to the processing of his or her personal data." (art 7 p.1)

In order for us to meet the requirements of the law, we would need your written consent for Brighter Leaders to process the information that you voluntarily disclose to us in order to achieve the purpose that has brought us together. You do this by clicking on the "I Agree" box.

At any time, you can ask us to access this information and/ or ask us to delete it.
